18. This two and a half story home has several distinguishing architectural features. Sided in yellow clapboards with scalloped shingles in its gables this house has 2/2 light windows capped in simple cornices. The front facade is characterized by an open wraparound porch with turned columns that have integrated brackets and a gingerbread railing, the double arched windows of the second story crowned in a detailed pediment, and the bay window protruding from the south side of the house. The rear wing of the house has new vinyl replacement windows, casement windows on its north side, and new French doors opening to the refurbished back porch. Skylights have been added to the third story. The yard is well kept with a hedge dividing the large side yard into front and back. This house retains its historic integrity as do the houses to its north and south.
